Admission Policy

The principles underlying university admission

1. solid acquisition of basic knowledge, skills, and an understanding of a wide variety of subjects concerning school education and developmental support

2. power of critical thinking, judgement, self-expression, the ability to form opinions, make decisions, and explain issues concerning school education and developmental support

3. the ability to conduct practical research concerning school education and developmental support, and apply the results of this research

4. interest in and motivation to research issues concerning school education and developmental support

5. a sense of ethics and responsibility as a member of society

6. a 'global mind', that is, to understand students' growth, the Japanese school education system, and its issues from an international perspective
