Admission Policy

The principles underlying university admission

- 1. solid acquisition of basic knowledge, skills, and an understanding of a wide variety of subjects concerning school education and developmental support
- 2. power of critical thinking, judgement, self-expression, the ability to form opinions, make decisions, and explain issues concerning school education and developmental support
- 3. the ability to conduct practical research concerning school education and developmental support, and apply the results of this research
- 4. interest in and motivation to research issues concerning school education and developmental support
- 5. a sense of ethics and responsibility as a member of society
- 6. a 'global mind', that is, to understand students' growth, the Japanese school education system, and its issues from an international perspective
