授業の概要

One aim of general education at Kagawa University is to help students develop a wide range of communication skills. This course builds upon the basic English communication skills developed by students in their first year (in Communicative English I/II).

授業の目的

This course focuses on the development of students' written communication skills. The primary objective is for students to improve their English writing skills by the end of the 15-week semester.

到達目標

By the end of the semester, students should be enabled to:

- 1. Communicate with others about their writing.
- 2. Write well-structured English paragraphs.
- 3. Know limitations of Google Translate/Chat GPT.

The above criteria are in line with General Education standards at Kagawa University. (To develop basic problem-solving skills) (To broaden one's knowledge of the humanities, society, and the environment)

Students will be evaluated on the following: In-class writing assignments: 20% (txt files to Moodle), Mid-term exam 1: 40%, Mid-term exam 2: 40% (dictionaries NOT allowed)
